

PISTOL AND RIFLE RANGE RULES - VIOLATIONS ARE SUBJECT TO LOSS OF MEMBERSHIP

- Sign yourself and your guests in and out at the podium just inside the gate.
- Paper Targets only. Throw away your targets when finished.
- Targets must be attached on the black belting only, not on the vertical beams.
- Maximum of 6 rounds may be loaded in the magazine or revolver.
- NO RAPID FIRE more than 6 rounds in 10 seconds is rapid fire
- All rounds must impact berm behind the target area
- Do not handle your firearm while people are forward of the firing line
- Do not loan your key to anyone
- You may be asked to identify yourself. Carry your membership card always.
- Clean up after yourself. Remove your targets and pick up your brass.
- Do not drive vehicles down onto range. If using a Handicapped placard, drive person and equipment onto range and then park in parking lot if able.
- The range is for members only and 2 guests. Exceptions for club approved events.
- Range hours: 10am to dusk 7 days per week
- \$20 yearly range fee is assessed per key.
- Keys may be purchased at the shotgun office after January 1st. (See hours at range or website or office)

SHOTGUN SPORTS RANGES RULES - VIOLATIONS ARE SUBJECT TO LOSS OF MEMBERSHIP

- Shot size shall not exceed U.S. No. 7 ½ Normal Spherical Shot, Plated Shot is permitted, no longer than 2 ¾ inches.
- Pick up your own shell hulls and any trash
- Do not load more than 1 shell when shooting Trap, no more than 2 shells for Skeet, Wobble Trap, 5 Stand and Sporting Clays, unless competing in a staff supervised event.
- Keep actions open until on station. Do not load until on station and pointing your shotgun down range.
- Minimum overall shotgun length = 26 inch
- Minimum barrel length = 18 inch

FUNDAMENTAL NRA RULES FOR SAFE GUN HANDLING -

VIOLATIONS ARE SUBJECT TO LOSS OF MEMBERSHIP

- Keep the firearm pointed in a safe direction
- Keep your finger off the trigger until ready to fire
- Keep the firearm unloaded until ready to use
- Know your target and what is beyond
- Be sure the firearm is safe to operate, know your firearm and how to use it.
- Use correct ammunition for the firearm.
- Eye and Ear protection mandatory.
- Use of alcohol or drugs before or during range use is forbidden.
- Unattended firearms should not be accessible to unauthorized persons.
